E-tender was floated for six different schemes of construction of Anganwadi
Centers in different blocks of the district under IMDP on 7.1.2014.


After opening of technical bid today in presence of six bidders (name included in
attendee list) the committee has reached the decision to accept four schemes for
opening of financial bid, viz those pertaining to Kalimpong I(Work number 1),
Darjeeling Pulbazar(Work number 2), Jorebunglow SUkiapokri(Work number 4),
and Gorubathan(Work number 5).

The bids for Work numbers 3 and 6 pertaining to Mirik and Kurseong block
respectively have been selected for re-tender since the number of qualified bids
were found to be less than 3(three) vide Finance Dept Memorandum No. 9754-

F(Y) dated 3.12.2012. Therefore the financial bids for the same will not be opened.

Moreover, in two cases it was found that the EMD was not submitted in both soft copy and hard copy as was required in the NIT. It has been decided that since the tender is being floated online in government's E-tender portal the submission of EMD in soft copy is a mandatory requirement. Therefore submission of hard copy only will be liable for rejection. However in then case where soft copy has been submitted in time the same will be considered as a valid bid even if the hard copy was not submitted in time.
